

THE DELHI POLICE ACT, 1978

(i) a refreshment room, boarding house or coffee house, or

(k) "entertainment" means any place where music, dancing or game or any other amusement, diversion or recreation is carried on, whether by means of carrying on the same is provided, whether or not any fee or charge is admitted either on payment of money, or with the intention that any fee or charge may be collected from those admitted and includes a place where a performance of a play, theatre, music hall, billiard or bagatelle room, gymnasium, or any other place for swimming pool or dancing hall;

Place of public entertainment:

Another case of *S.L. Governor Delhi and others v. Union of India*, 38 (1989) D.L.T 357 upheld the decision of the Hon'ble High Court that the act of furnishing accommodation for lodging house where social or undesirable activities and question of public order is same in case such a lodging house is used for public entertainment.

(m) "Police officer" means any member of the Delhi Police;

(n) "Prescribed" means prescribed by rules;

(o) "public place" means any place to which the public have access as of right or not, and



(i) a public building and monument and precincts thereof;

(ii) any place accessible to the public for drawing water, bathing or for purposes of recreation;
